Dear TAMUQ Faculty and Staff,

The Texas A&M and Qatar Foundation transition teams are working closely to be able to share information about the staffing transition plan as soon as possible. While these plans are being finalized, we will continue to share updates and information about future opportunities. This week, Texas A&M is rolling out HR workshops and a portal for both faculty and staff to express interest in coming to work in Texas.

The workshops have already begun and cover retirement benefits and job search topics. You may find the dates and times on the portal and in separate email communications from HROE.

The portal links to a site with all Texas A&M University System job boards, as well as available Texas A&M University jobs and other resources. All faculty and staff are welcome to apply for posted positions.

Faculty and staff should be aware that only some positions are eligible for United States non-immigrant visa sponsorship. Eligibility for sponsorship for a visa to work in the United States is typically based on the educational qualifications to work on a specialty occupation or extraordinary ability in the fields of science.
