

Prohibited Items

Prior to purchasing or selecting items to be shipped to Qatar, find below a list of prohibited items:

Items Prohibited by Qatar Customs:

- Narcotics/illegal drugs of any kind
- Pornography in any form, any publications depicting semi-nudity including fashion Magazines
- Politically sensitive materials, literature or videos contrary to Muslim, and/or Arab beliefs and morality
- Explosives, ammunition, and weapons
- Alcohol or products containing alcohol
- Imitation/copies of brand products over 3 pieces
- Medication will be transfer to the ministry of health
- Pork and any items containing pork product
- Ivory and any items made of ivory

Items prohibited either by federal law or shipping company standards:

- Combustibles (alcohol, lubricants, antifreeze)
- Explosives (fireworks, flash bulbs, small arms ammunition)
- Compressed Gas (aerosol cans, fire extinguishers, scuba diving tanks)
- Corrosives (acids, drain cleaner, photographic chemicals, batteries, water purifying agents, bleach, fertilizers, weed killer)
- Flammable (gasoline, butane, propane, propane/butane tanks, lighter fluids, perfume, matches, wood oil stains, petrol-based garden sprays, paint, varnish, paint removers, signal flares, charcoal briquettes, chemicals)
- Wood, lumber, bricks, building materials
- Other (live plants, seeds, fresh fruit, flowers, poisons)
- Laptop computers, medicine, vitamins, fur, jewelry, coins and stamp collections

Consider not to shipping personal items that have great sentimental value to avoid exposure to damage and/or customs.

Standard airline rules apply to checked and carryon luggage for airline travel.
